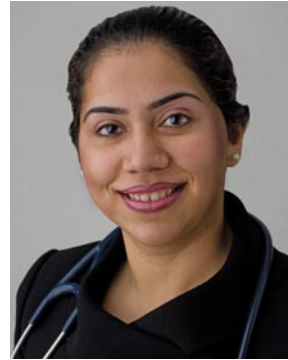
## TERRI F. KATZ, M.D.

## INDERPREET SACHAR, M.D.

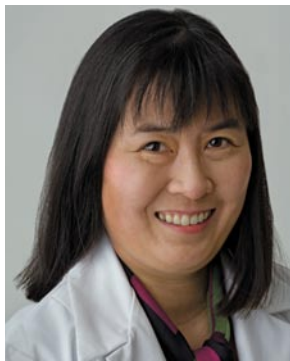
